The first report for the 2016 election period is the Supplemental Report due on February 2, 2015, covering the period from November 5 through December 31, 2014.

The Noncandidate Committee may terminate its registration and reporting requirements by filing the "Request for Termination of Registration" form, if the Noncandidate Committee has no surplus or deficit and the Commission approves the request.
