REGISTRATION DEADLINES

□ Organizational Report The Organizational Report must be filed within ten days of filing nomination papers for office or within ten days of the date the candidate or candidate's committee receives contributions or makes expenditures that amount to more than \$100 in the aggregate during the applicable election period, whichever occurs first.
□ Affidavit To Voluntarily Agree With Campaign Expenditure Limits (Form CC-2) The Affidavit must be filed no later than the time of filing nomination papers with the chief election officer or county clerk.
□ Statement Of Intent To Seek Public Funds (Form CC-4) The Statement must be filed before contributions can be considered qualifying contributions for the purpose of receiving matching public funds. There is no specific deadline for filing the Statement.

At the conclusion of the 2014 election period on November 4, 2014, candidates with a surplus or deficit must continue reporting with the Commission until the surplus has been disbursed or the deficit has been cleared. The first report for the 2018 election period for four-year offices is the Supplemental Report due on February 2, 2015, covering the period from November 5 through December 31, 2014.

The candidate committee may terminate its registration and reporting requirements by filing the "Request for Termination of Registration" form, if the candidate committee has no surplus or deficit and the Commission approves the request.
