

**SCHEDULE OF REPORTING DATES FOR
CANDIDATES RUNNING IN THE 2016 ELECTION
FOR THE FOLLOWING OFFICES:
STATE SENATE (DISTRICTS 1 AND 5),
STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVE,
AND NEIGHBOR ISLAND COUNTY COUNCIL
(2014-2016 Election Period)
(Revised February, 2016)**

REGISTRATION DEADLINES

- Organizational Report
The Organizational Report must be filed within ten days of filing nomination papers for office or within ten days of the date the candidate or candidate's committee receives contributions or makes expenditures that amount to more than \$100 in the aggregate during the applicable election period, whichever occurs first.
- Affidavit To Voluntarily Agree With Campaign Expenditure Limits (Form CC-2)
The Affidavit must be filed no later than the time of filing nomination papers with the chief election officer or county clerk.
- Statement Of Intent To Seek Public Funds (Form CC-4)
The Statement must be filed before contributions can be considered qualifying contributions for the purpose of receiving matching public funds. There is no specific deadline for filing the Statement.

At the conclusion of the General Election on November 8, 2016, candidates still registered with the Campaign Spending Commission ("Commission") must continue to electronically file reports online in the CFS until their final disclosure report has a zero balance and a request to terminate is submitted to and approved by the Commission. The first report due after the General Election is the Supplemental Report covering the reporting period of November 9 through December 31, 2016. This report is due on January 31, 2017.
