REGISTRATION DEADLINES

- Organizational Report
The Organizational Report for a candidate committee shall be filed within ten days of the date the candidate files nomination papers for office **or** within ten days of the date the candidate or candidate committee receives contributions or makes or incurs expenditures of more than \$100 in the aggregate during the applicable election period, whichever is earlier.
- Affidavit To Voluntarily Agree With Campaign Expenditure Limits (Form CC-2)
The Affidavit must be filed no later than the time of filing nomination papers with the chief election officer or county clerk.
- Statement Of Intent To Seek Public Funds (Form CC-4)
The Statement must be filed before contributions can be considered qualifying contributions for the purpose of receiving matching public funds. There is no specific deadline for filing the Statement.

(This is the first election-year report for candidates whose names did not appear on the Primary Election ballot but will appear on the General Election ballot.) |

(A candidate or candidate committee that receives contributions from any person aggregating more than \$500 within the period of fourteen calendar days through four calendar days prior to the <u>General Election</u> shall file a Late Contributions Report. <u>The report is not required if there are no late contributions.</u> Note: Late contributions will also be reported on the Final Election Period Report.) |

(For candidates that filed the Preliminary General Report.) |

(Required by candidates who received public funds for the <u>General Election</u> .) |
| □ December 6, 2018 | LAST DAY TO APPLY | Application For Public Funds |

ALERT

At the conclusion of the General Election on November 6, 2018, candidate committees still registered with the Campaign Spending Commission ("Commission") must continue to electronically file reports in the Candidate Filing System until their final disclosure report has no surplus or deficit, and a request to terminate is submitted to and approved by the Commission. The first report due after the General Election is the Supplemental Report covering the reporting period of November 7 through December 31, 2018. This report is due on January 31, 2019.
