## **REGISTRATION DEADLINES**

Organizational Report  The Organizational Report must be filed within ten days of filing nomination papers for office or within ten days of the date the candidate or candidate's committee receives contributions or makes expenditures that amount to more than \$100 in the aggregate during the applicable election period, whichever occurs first.
Affidavit To Voluntarily Agree With Campaign Expenditure Limits (Form CC-2)  The Affidavit must be filed no later than the time of filing nomination papers with the chief election officer or county clerk.
Statement Of Intent To Seek Public Funds (Form CC-4)  The Statement must be filed before contributions can be considered qualifying contributions for the purpose of receiving matching public funds. There is no specific deadline for filing the Statement.
