At the conclusion of the General Election on November 8, 2016, noncandidate committees still registered with the Campaign Spending Commission ("Commission") must continue to electronically file reports online in the Noncandidate Committee Filing System until their final disclosure report has a zero balance and a request to terminate is submitted to and approved by the Commission. The first report due after the General Election is the Supplemental Report covering the reporting period of November 9 through December 31, 2016. This report is due on January 31, 2017.
