## What You Need to Know about the *Hawaii Election Campaign Fund*

If you have a state tax liability of at least \$3, you have the option of marking “Yes” or “No” on your income tax return for \$3 (or \$6 if married and filing a joint return) to go to the **Hawaii Election Campaign Fund**.
