COMPTROLLER'S MEMORANDUM NO. 1997-16

TO: All Department Heads
SUBJECT: Procedural Changes for Post-Death Payroll Payments

Based upon a settlement between the United Public Workers and the State of Hawaii, the existing procedures for post-death payroll payments which were previously established by Comptroller's Memorandum No. 1989-13 and clarified by Comptroller's Memorandum No. 1990-8 are hereby amended to include the withholding of statutory dues and other specified deductions from "unpaid compensation" earned but not paid at the time of death. "Unpaid compensation" is defined as regular salary and does not include fringe pay and accumulated vacation pay.

Effective June 1, 1997, amounts for statutory dues and other specified deductions must be withheld from unpaid compensation and remitted to the appropriate agents. As a reminder, the deductions for social security and medicare taxes are withheld only if the post-death payment is processed in the year of the employee's death. The listing of required deductions are as follows:
