Relating to Office of Election Budget Provisions

As Required by  
Act 164, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011

July 25, 2012

Section 31 of Act 164, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, provides that the Office of Elections will submit quarterly reports concerning (1) vacancies; (2) travel and overtime expenditures; (3) milestones, accomplishments and activities of the Chief Election Officer; and (4) an updated planning timeline for the 2012 Elections. The following is a report of the Office of Elections for the fourth quarter of Fiscal Year 2012, covering the time period of April 1, 2012 through June 30, 2012.

*(1) An updated list of vacant positions, noting current recruitment status.*

The following positions were vacant at the end of the quarter.

As we are a few months away from the Primary Election, we have filled most of our seasonal positions. The remaining seasonal positions will be hired in closer proximity to the Primary Election.

*(2) A detail of travel and overtime expenditures of the quarter, including justification or reason for expenditure.*

The Elections Commission held a meeting on Oahu during the last quarter. As such, travel expenditures were made for neighbor island members to attend the meeting. Office of Elections staff traveled to the neighbor islands to perform preparations for the upcoming elections. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a true and correct copy of a Microsoft Excel spreadsheet reflecting in detail expenditures posted to the state financial accounting and management information system (FAMIS) during the last fiscal quarter.

There were overtime expenditures during the last quarter. Overtime was provided to staff to do the following: (1) conduct trainings of various categories of election day officials; (2) recruit election day officials; (3) proof ballots and election related documents; (4) inventory, pack and distribute precinct supplies; (5) inventory and pack ballots; and (6) to perform various other duties associated with preparing for the 2012 Elections. Attached hereto as Exhibit B is a true and correct copy of a spreadsheet listing the amount of overtime, per position title/number, for each pay period.

*(3) A detailed listing of milestones, accomplishments, and activities of the chief election officer and each section occurring during the quarter.*

*Chief Election Officer.* The Chief Election Officer serves as the secretary to the Reapportionment Commission and provides all necessary technical assistance. Article IV, Section 2. On April 6, 2012, the most recent plan of the Reapportionment Commission was challenged in the United States District Court for the District of Hawaii. The plaintiffs sought for the formulation and implementation of a new reapportionment plan for the 2012 Elections.

The State's position was that a change in the reapportionment plan so close to the elections would compromise our ability to implement the elections. Plaintiffs filed a motion for preliminary injunction to stop the State from using the current plan. The hearing on the motion was held on May 18, 2012.

Staff time was consumed with having to address this risk to our elections. Staff provided support to the Department of the Attorney General to assist it in familiarizing itself with the technical details of the reapportionment process. The Chief Election Officer had to be deposed by plaintiffs and had to assist the Department of the Attorney General in preparing declarations and other documents for the Court to explain the logistical and administrative issues that would occur if the plan were to be revised at such a late date.

Ultimately, on May 22, 2012, the Court issued its order denying plaintiffs' motion. Essentially, plaintiffs failed to meet their burden to obtain a preliminary injunction. The Court, in issuing its decision, noted the following:

Any effort to implement an alternative plan at this stage would result in significant delay, grave confusion and potential chaos at the polls. Such a result is directly contrary to the powerful public interest in avoiding disruption of the primary election, which "is an integral part of the entire election process." *Burdick v. Takushi*, 504 U.S. 428, 439 (1992).

\* \* \*

Although Kostick's counsel opined at the hearing that the task would be "mission difficult, not mission impossible," we disagree. **The above chronology leaves little doubt that, at this late date, there is no room for judicial intervention without significantly interrupting the election process. Spawning chaos rather than confidence in the election process is a result we cannot endorse.** Absent compelling evidence that the election will not be interrupted, we find that the equities and public interest weigh decisively against granting the preliminary injunction.

The case continues, but on a longer litigation path, which won't be resolved until after the 2012 Elections. As such, the Office of Elections was able to refocus its efforts, for the remainder of the quarter, on preparing for the conducting of the 2012 Elections.

*Ballot Operations Section.* This section has continued to be involved in planning and implementing candidate filing, processing political party petitions, working with the vendor on ballot printing matters, and finalizing other logistical matters related to the printing, delivery, and collection of ballots. A seasonal election specialist was hired and trained during this quarter to provide additional support for these responsibilities.

*Computer Services Section.* This section continued its support of all the information and technology needs of the Office of Elections. The polling place locator was dispatched onto our website, during this quarter, to facilitate voters finding their polling place. In addition, the section head continued to provide support to the Reapportionment Commission as it dealt with litigation challenging its plan filed on March 8, 2012.

*Counting Center Operations Section.* The section head position continues to be vacant. However, the seasonal election specialist position for this section has been filled. The Chief Election Officer, who previously held the position of counting center operations section head, has continued to work with the vendor, train the seasonal employee, reserve facilities as counting centers, and take other steps to ensure the preparation of the section for the elections.

*Election Support Services Section.* This section continued to receive, process, and report all financial transactions and activities of the Office of Elections to the Department of Accounting and General Services to which it is attached for administrative purposes. The section has also continued with preventive maintenance on election equipment and supplies, including trips to the neighbor islands for that purpose. Finally, this section has begun the process of delivering equipment and supplies to various polling places in advance of the Primary Election.

*Precinct Operations Section.* This section has been recruiting chairpersons, voter assistance officials, and precinct officials for the operation of the precinct polling places. This section has also had to participate in numerous sessions to properly train these recruits to perform their duties on election day. Finally, this section was involved in finalizing the precincts to be used for the 2012 Elections, based upon the most recent reapportionment lines filed with the Office of Elections on March 8, 2012.

*Voter Services Section.* This section has been focused on voter outreach in regards to registering voters and in finalizing educational materials. Additionally, contracts have been completed to ensure compliance with the voter information and dispute resolution requirements of the Help America Vote Act. Finally, contracts with various media outlets have been entered into to ensure the statewide dissemination of election information to the public.

*(4) Updated planning timeline for the 2012 elections, including justification of any changes from the previously reported timeline.*

There have been no changes to the previously submitted planning timeline for the 2012 Elections.
