## Description of Kula Pipe Line.

across land of Kealahou 3 and 4,  
Kamehamenui and Grant 3874 to Chi Lung.

Now owned by Mrs. Dora von Tempsky.

Beginning at a point on the boundary of Kealahou 1 and 2  
and Kealahou 3 and 4, from which a + on a large rock at mauka corner  
of Kealahou 1 and 2 is by true azimuth  $307^{\circ} 11'$  270.4 feet, and  
running along general line of pipe by true azimuths:-

1.  $221^{\circ} 22'$  166.0 feet along the slope;
2.  $229^{\circ} 38'$  383.0 feet along the slope;
3.  $211^{\circ} 04'$  316.8 feet along the slope;
4.  $197^{\circ} 39'$  163.6 feet along the slope;
5.  $205^{\circ} 54'$  159.1 feet along the slope;
6.  $207^{\circ} 54'$  262.8 feet along the slope crossing the Kula Homestead  
Road and Waipapa Gulch to + on a solid  
rock, from this point the 9 Mile Post  
is by true azimuth  $307^{\circ} 00' 59.8$  feet;
7.  $221^{\circ} 44'$  359.0 feet across Kula Homestead Road and slope to  
ridge, from which point the Government  
Survey Trig. Station "Waipapa" is by  
true azimuth  $156^{\circ} 30' 115.7$  feet;
8.  $215^{\circ} 12'$  751.8 feet across ridge, gully and up slope;
9.  $208^{\circ} 48'$  221.9 feet across small gully;
10.  $212^{\circ} 36'$  153.0 feet to West edge of Keauaiwi Gulch.
