Beginning at a + on a stone at the North side of a 20 foot Right-of-Way for railroad and at the East corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 5, from which a + on a stone at the angle of the Government Main Road and the Railroad Right-of-Way is by true azimuth and distance $250^{\circ} 20' 84.4$ feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2450, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $70^{\circ} 20'$ 116.4 feet along 20 Foot Railroad Right-of-Way;
2. $160^{\circ} 20'$ 74.8 feet along Lot 7 to the South bank of ditch;
3. $235^{\circ} 13'$ 76.6 feet along the South bank of ditch to + on stone;
4. $316^{\circ} 11'$ 103.8 feet along Lot 5, Block E, to the point of beginning.
