Lots 11, 12, and 13. Block I.

Kapaa Town Lots, Puna, Kauai.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 13 and the Southeast corner of Lot 14 and on the North side of Koa Street, from which a + on a stone at the Northwest corner of Koa and Church Streets is by true azimuth and distance  $270^{\circ} 00' 300.0$  feet and Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth  $66^{\circ} 43' 30''$ , as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2450, and running by true azimuths:

1.  $180^{\circ} 00'$  150.0 feet along Lot 14, Block I to a pipe;
2.  $270^{\circ} 00'$  150.0 feet along Lots 3 and 4, Block I, to a pipe;
3.  $360^{\circ} 00'$  150.0 feet along Lots 8, 9, and 10, Block I;
4.  $90^{\circ} 00'$  150.0 feet along Koa Street to the point of beginning.
