Kapaa Town Lots, Puna, Kauai.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 14, Block I, and the Southwest corner of Lot 13, Block I, and on the North side of Koa Street, from which a + on a stone at the Northwest corner of Koa and Church Streets is by true azimuth and distance $270^{\circ} 00'$ 300.0 feet and Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth $66^{\circ} 43' 30''$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2450, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 150.0 feet along Koa Street;
2. $180^{\circ} 00'$ 150.0 feet along Lot 17, Block I;
3. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 150.0 feet along Lots 1 and 2, Block I to a pipe;
4. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 150.0 feet along Lot 13, Block I, to the point of beginning.
