Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth $66^{\circ} 11'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2450, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $124^{\circ} 33'$ 85.2 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1;
2. $214^{\circ} 59'$ 123.7 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1;
3. $299^{\circ} 45'$ 40.7 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1;
4. $213^{\circ} 55'$ 24.9 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1;
5. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 87.0 feet along Lot 1, Block I;
6. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 150.0 feet along Lot 16, Block I;
7. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 136.9 feet along Koa Street to the point of beginning.
