Beginning at a post at the Northwest corner of this lot, on the Northeast side of 20 foot road and on the South boundary of L.C.A. 7628:2 to Keamio, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 6053.4 feet North and 1011.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 253° 33' 219.4 feet along L.C.A. 7628:2 to Keamio to a post;
2. 259° 58' 120.0 feet along L.C.A. 10518 to Nahuakai to a + on set stone and ahu;
3. 320° 30' 640.0 feet along Government land to a + on set stone and ahu;
4. 324° 05' 362.2 feet along L.C.A. 7612 to Kuaana and Kauaua to a post on the Northwest side of 30 foot road;
5. 7° 14' 433.0 feet along 30 foot road to a + on set stone;
6. 75° 11' 37.5 feet to a + on stone;
7. 143° 10' 1429.2 feet along 30 foot road to the point of beginning
