Lot 3.

Beginning at a \perp in stone, marked by an ahu, on the Eastern boundary of Grant 3153 to Mākia and Keaweikalāko, which is the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 4, the coordinates from Puu Nahaha \triangle being N 24625.3 feet, E 9161.9 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2171, and running by true bearings:-

1. N $14^{\circ} 00'$ W 1027.2 feet along Grant 3153 to Mākia and Keaweikaliko to ahu;
2. N $79^{\circ} 30'$ E 25168.7 feet along Lot 2 to ahu on Kahuku Boundary, the coordinates from Pualehua \triangle being S 5766.3 feet, W 1241.9 feet;
3. S $05^{\circ} 05'$ E 1244.9 feet along Kahuku to ahu at Northeast corner Lot 4;
4. S $79^{\circ} 30'$ W 25812.0 feet along Lot 4 to initial point.

Reserving however, ^{the} from the above, a ^{strip} 40 feet ^{wide for} roadway ^{across} near the ~~Western~~ ^{and western} boundary of this lot, and leaving a net area of 599.0 acres.
