Station "Aku" being 4852.9 feet North and 1489.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 183° 05' 415.2 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a + on set stone and ahu;
2. 179° 35' 208.4 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a post;
3. 270° 00' 553.7 feet along Lot 2 to a post;
4. 360° 00' 623.0 feet along Lot 5 to a post on the North side of 20 foot road;
5. 90° 00' 574.3 feet along 20 foot road to the point of beginning.
