Beginning at a spike in rock and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 5 and on the North boundary of land of Alae I (Grant 2036 to Beniamina), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahoehoe" being ^{339.4}~~339.9~~ feet South and ^{988.1}~~988.2~~ feet East, as ²⁰⁴~~214~~ shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2702, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 81° 40' 116.2 feet along Alae I (Grant 2036 to Beniamina) to a pipe in ahu;
2. 89° 20' 502.6 feet along same to a pipe in ahu;
3. 179° 35' 398.6 feet along Lot 3 to a pipe in ahu;
4. 266° 40' 618.6 feet along Haukalua I (Grant 1970 to Kalaaukane) to a pipe;
5. 359° 35' 412.1 feet along Lot 5 to the point of beginning.

Area 5-85/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a road 30 feet wide along the South boundary of this lot, as shown on plan hereto attached and made a part hereof, Area 42/100 of an Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 5-43/100 ACRES.
