Lots 4-5.

Alika Homesteads,  
South Kona, Hawaii.

Beginning at a + on stone, marked by an ahu on the North boundary of Papa Homesteads, which is the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Grant 3153 to Mikia and Keaweikaliko, the coordinates from "Puu Nahaha" Trig. Station being 22,474.5 feet North and 9698.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2171, and running by true bearings:-

1. N. 14° 00' W. 2216.6 feet along Grant 3153 to Mikia and Keaweikaliko to an ahu;
2. N. 79° 30' E. 25812.0 feet along Lot 3 to an ahu on the Kahuku boundary, the coordinates from "Pualehua" Trig. Station being 6645.7 feet South and 361.0 feet West;
3. S. 45° 03' E. 2398.2 feet along the Kahuku boundary to an ahu on Papa I boundary;
4. S. 79° 30' W. 26508.0 feet along Papa I to an ahu at the Northeast corner of Papa Homesteads.
5. S. 55° 20' W. 579.6 feet along Papa Homesteads to the point of beginning.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a Forty (40) foot roadway along near the West boundary of these lots, and leaving a net area of 1198 Acres.
