Beginning at a + on set stone and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 3, on the boundary between the lands of Kealakehe and Keahuolu, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Keahuolu" being 5507.5 feet North and 11870.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2122, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 74° 08' 118.0 feet to a + on set stone, the same being on the boundary of the lands of Kealakehe and Keahuolu;
2. 75° 15' 1414.0 feet to a + on set stone and ahu on the boundary between the lands of Kealakehe and Keahuolu;
3. 155° 06' 2274.5 feet along Lot 7 to a + on set stone and ahu;
4. 258° 37' 1550.0 feet along 50 foot road to a + on set stone and ahu, the same being the Northwest corner of Lot 3;
5. 335° 06' 2179.6 feet along Lot 3 to the point of beginning.
