Station is by true azimuth and distance 156° 18' 510.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 47' 166.3 feet along L.C.A.4621:3 to Pehuiki to a + on stone;
2. 260° 17' 144.3 feet along Lot 4-A to a + on stone;
3. 358° 19' 180.5 feet along Lots 6-A and 7-A to a + on stone;
4. 85° 54' 135.8 feet along Lot 7-A to the point of beginning.
