Beginning at a post at the Northwest corner of this lot on the South side of a 20 foot road, and on the boundary of the land of Pakini-iki, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 4832.9 feet North and 1490.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 270° 00' 635.2 feet along 20 foot road to a post;
2. 360° 00' 536.2 feet along Lots 7 and 10 to a post;
3. 90° 00' 663.7 feet along Lot 9 to a post;
4. 183° 03' 537.0 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to the point of beginning.
