Beginning at a + on the East face of a stonewall at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 8 on the South boundary of Grant 1870 to Hewahewa, the co-ordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akahipu" being 7393.0 feet South and 1326.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2431, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 358° 53' 444.0 feet along stonewall along Lot 8 to a + on stone in wall 13.5 feet North of present wall corner;
2. 96° 00' 442.0 feet along North side of a 20 foot road to a stonewall;
3. 83° 15' 371.0 feet along North side of a 20 foot road to a point 42.0 feet South of present wall corner;
4. 179° 00' 425.0 feet along stonewall along Lot 6 to a + on set stone and ahu in cross wall;
5. 276° 05' 179.0 feet along Grant 1870 to Hewahewa to ahu;
6. 265° 27' 265.0 feet along Grant 1870 to Hewahewa to ahu;
7. 255° 18' 116.0 feet along Grant 1870 to Hewahewa to ahu;
8. 273° 35' 253.0 feet along Grant 1870 to Hewahewa to the point of beginning.


# Description of Lot 7.

Haleohia North Kona Hawaii.

Beginning at the N.E. corner of Lot 6 and running as follows by true bearings.

1. S.  $85^{\circ} 15' E$ . 171. ft along Gr. 1870 Hewahewa.
2. N.  $83^{\circ} 40' E$ . 264 " " " "
3. N.  $69^{\circ} 20' E$ . 110 " " " "
4. S.  $88^{\circ} 25' E$ . 280 " " " "
5. South 490 " " Lot 8.
6. N.  $84^{\circ} 00' W$  450 " " 20 ft Roadway.
7. S.  $83^{\circ} 15' W$ . 375 " " " "
8. North 435 " " Lot 6 is the initial front and containing over area of  $8.000$  acres.
