Beginning at a post at the Southwest corner of this lot , on the boundary of the land of Pakini-iki, and the North side of a 20 foot road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 3783.3 feet North and 1548.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 191° 03' 18.8 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a + on set stone and ahu;
2. 183° 03' 495.6 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a post;
3. 270° 00' 663.7 feet along Lot 6 to a post;
4. 360° 00' 513.4 feet along Lot 10 to a post on the North side of the 20 foot road;
5. 90° 00' 693.6 feet along the 20 foot road to the point of beginning.
