Beginning at a rock marked \triangle at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 11, the said \triangle on rock marking the common point of the lands of Kukuipahu, Awalua and Kahei, the coordinates of said \triangle referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Nale" being 3035.9 feet North and 682.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2390, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $181^{\circ} 50'$ 574.0 feet along the land of Kukuipahu, L.C.A. 9912 to Pihō to a post;
2. $290^{\circ} 05'$ 1072.0 feet along Lot 8 to a post;
3. $29^{\circ} 28'$ 282.0 feet along the Northwest side of 30 Foot Road to a post;
4. $92^{\circ} 35'$ 887.0 feet along Lot 11 to the point of beginning.
