Station being N. 77° 04' East, 1893.5 feet, as shown on Homestead Map No. 11 on file in the Office of the Government Survey and running by true bearings:-

1. N. 26° 50' W. 845 feet along Lots 13 and 12;
2. N. 68° 30' E. 740 feet along L.C.A. 10070:1 to Mici and Lot 8 to an ahu;
3. N. 71° 35' E. 205 feet along L.C.A. 7897:1 to Kahuenui;
4. S. 27° 45' E. 778 feet along Lot 6 to an ahu on North side of 20 foot road;
5. S. 65° 10' W. 955 feet along said road to the point of beginning.
