Beginning at a + on stone at the East corner of Lot 1 and the North corner of Lot 2, on the South side of Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Transit of Venus" being 480.8 feet South and 779.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2596, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 299° 37' 39.0 feet along South side of Government Main Road;
2. 21° 35' 47.7 feet along Lot 3;
3. 307° 46' 64.0 feet along same;
4. 35° 42' 89.0 feet along Northwest side of road leading to wharf;
5. 194° 56' 36.9 feet to Southeast corner of L.C.A. 6638, Apana 1, to Namokuliu;
6. 210° 51' 46.3 feet along same;
7. 132° 14' 130.4 feet along same;
8. 255° 52' 49.6 feet along Ili of Kikiola to the point of beginning.
