Alae 3 & 4 Homesteads,

Beginning at a mamane post at the West corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 2 and on the East side of 40 foot homestead road, from which the Waiakoa Catholic Church Spire is by true azimuth $154^{\circ} 42'$ and the coordinates referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu Kahala" are 12143.5 feet South and 23118.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2239, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $261^{\circ} 35'$ 848.0 feet along Lot 2 to an arrow \rightarrow on large solid rock at angle of fence amidst a grove of eucalyptus trees, the true azimuth to Waiakoa Catholic Church Spire is $150^{\circ} 10'$
2. $300^{\circ} 50'$ 1403.0 feet along fence along the land of Waiakoa;
3. $34^{\circ} 00'$ 762.0 feet along Forest Reserve to a mamane post;
4. $142^{\circ} 03'$ 400.0 feet along East side of homestead road;
5. $159^{\circ} 50'$ 109.0 feet along East side of homestead road;
6. $135^{\circ} 40'$ 299.0 feet along East side of homestead road to a mamane post;
7. $113^{\circ} 33'$ 503.0 feet along East side of homestead road to a mamane post;
8. $126^{\circ} 39'$ 99.0 feet along East side of homestead road to a mamane post;
9. $109^{\circ} 00'$ 278.0 feet along East side of homestead road to a mamane post;
10. $127^{\circ} 36'$ 398.0 feet along East side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
