KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

KAU, HAWAII.

Lot 1.

Beginning at + on large stone and ahu on side hill on the boundary between Waiohinu and Kiolakaa, at a point called Napalua whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 5870 feet S and 19110 feet E. and from which Waiohinu Prot. Church steeple bears S 54° 5' E true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings, all points being marked by + on stone and ahu, unless otherwise described:-

1. N 32° 12' W 1770 feet along Waiohinu to a rocky ahu;
2. S 47° 50' W 2875 feet along Lots <sup>and 2-A</sup> 2-C to a point on side of pali;
3. S 51° 00' E 415 feet along Lot 16-B to a point at base of pali;
4. S 57° 5' E 1502 feet along <sup>Lots 16-B and 16-A</sup> ~~the same~~ to a point on side hill 15 feet

East of stone wall;

5. S 52° 47' W 420 feet <sup>along Lot 16-A</sup> to a point on a kahua hale;
6. S 62° 18' E 1835 feet along Grant 1532 Kamalii to + on rock and ahu;
7. N 49° 37' W 837 feet along Grant 808 Kaulia;
8. N 58° 55' E 1482 feet along the same;
9. N 18° 29' W 1380 feet along Waiohinu to the initial point and containing an area of 155 Acres.
