1. 341° 22' 850.0 feet along ^{Hakalau Iki House Lots}~~Government Reserve~~ to an iron rail;
2. 56° 55' 495.0 feet along Lot 9 to an iron rail;
3. 147° 20' 983.0 feet along Lot 2 to an iron rail on the South side of Mountain Road;
4. 249° 45' 718.0 feet along Mountain Road to the point of beginning
