Beginning at a pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of a Government Reserve and on the South side of a homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2157.1 feet North and 1673.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 258° 02' 146.25 feet along South side of homestead road to a pipe;
2. 250° 01' 589.45 feet along South side of homestead road to a post;
3. 237° 27' 572.25 feet along South side of homestead road to a pipe;
4. 257° 13' 336.75 feet along South side of homestead road to a post;
5. 263° 08' 357.50 feet along South side of homestead road to a pipe on the West line of a Government Reserve;
6. 354° 50' 76.3 feet along West line of a Government Reserve to nail in post, the same being 10 feet from the edge of stream;
7. Westerly along a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being: 67° 06' 30" 2005.39 feet;
8. 173° 39' 200.4 feet along the East side of a Government Reserve to the point of beginning.
