Beginning at a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot and on the boundary of the lands of Kulaimano and Pepeekeo, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Alala" being 2994.9 feet South and 1638.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2497, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 335° 04' 708.0 feet along Government Reserve to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 245° 04' 586.5 feet along Government Reserve to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 335° 04' 222.4 feet along Lot 2 to a 2 inch galvanized iron at edge of Waiama Gulch;
