Lepoloa-Kauniho Homesteads,
North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina^(Old)" being 766.8 feet North and 5206.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2588, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 228° 00' 524.4 feet crossing Hawaii Consolidated Railway Limited along Grant 3372 to J. Coerper to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;

Thence along top edge of sea bluff
the direct azimuths and distances being:

2.	308° 13'	304.4 feet;
3.	344° 30'	200.0 feet;
4.	320° 30'	200.0 feet;
5.	272° 50'	220.0 feet;
6.	343° 20'	480.0 feet;
7.	314° 10'	560.0 feet;
8.	332° 38'	256.1 feet to a 1½ inch galvanized iron pipe;

9. 61° 12' 270.1 feet crossing Hawaii Consolidated Railway Limited along the land of Umauma to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;

10. 164° 45' 467.0 feet along flume right-of-way;

11. 125° 40' 1633.1 feet along flume right-of-way to the point of beginning.

Area 14-56/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a strip of land 60 feet wide across this lot for right-of-way for the Hawaii Consolidated Railway Limited, as shown on plan made a part hereof, said right-of-way containing an area of 2-88/100 Acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 11-68/100 ACRES.
