5. 310° 52' 347.6 feet along road reserve to + on stone;
6. 315° 46' 1707.7 feet along road reserve to + on stone;
7. 331° 16' 1329.6 feet along road reserve to + on stone;
8. 291° 16' 682.6 feet along road reserve to + on stone;
9. 297° 12' 702.5 feet along Government Reserve to + on stone;
10. 20° 47' 881.4 feet along Government Reserve to + on stone;
11. 110° 37' 2136.0 feet along Government Reserve to + on stone;
12. 96° 39' 1799.0 feet along Government Reserve to + on stone;
13. 111° 28' 3184.0 feet along Government Reserve to + on stone;
14. 125° 25' 1967.3 feet along Government Reserve to the initial point.

Reserving therefrom, the Drain Ditch, 100 feet wide, near the the East end of this lot, and leaving a net area of 512.0 Acres.
