



Awini, N. Kohala, Hawaii.

Govt. Lots.

Lot #13.

Notes of Survey:-

Beginning at a marked post at edge of Honokea gulch, this point being the common angle of lots #11, #12 and the said lot #13, the coordinates being S. 14243.3 ft. referred to Awini Ref. Station, the bdy. runs by the true meridian:-

- 1-N. 90°00'E.- 304.0 ft. more or less, along lot #11, down the pali of gulch to point at N.E. angle in middle of stream, thence following the middle of stream, said middle being the boundary.
- 2-S. 08°05'E.- 2576.0 " to S.E. angle in stream, thence up pali of gulch.
- 3-S. 90°00'W.- 252.0 " more or less, up said pali to marked post at edge of same, the coordinates being S. 16796.7 ft. referred to Awini Ref. Station. E. 893.8
- 4-S. 90°00'W.- 1160.0 " along unsurveyed remainder of Awini to marked post at edge of the Honokaneiki gulch, thence down the pali of said gulch to middle of stream.
- 5-S. 90°00'W.- 200.0 " more or less, to S.W. angle in said stream, thence down the stream, the middle thereof being the bdy.
- 6-N. 20°40'W.- 2721.0 " to N.W. angle in stream, thence up pali of gulch.
- 7-N. 90°00'E.- 95.0 " more or less, along lot #12 to marked post at edge of pali.
- 8-N. 90°00'E.- 1806.0 " to point of beginning.

Containing an area of 102.1 acres, more or less.
