1. 182° 00' 278.76 feet along Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
2. 260° 20' 161.33 feet along Grant 2495 to Kahulanui & Maheanana to a pipe;
3. 2° 00' 311.38 feet along Lot 15 to a pipe;
4. 92° 00' 158.00 feet along Road (50 feet wide) to the point of beginning.
