Beginning at "XIII" marked on solid rock at wall corner at the East corner of this lot, and on the Northwest side of old road to Waimea, the true azimuth and distance to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaipohaku" (marked by spike in rock) being $152^{\circ} 59'$ 1207.5 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2430, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $91^{\circ} 29'$ 174.5 feet along North side of old road to Waimea to drill hole in stone;
2. $61^{\circ} 51'$ 580.0 feet along same to + on set stone;
3. $69^{\circ} 53'$ 258.3 feet along same to + on solid rock and ahu;
4. $84^{\circ} 00'$ 271.5 feet along same to rock marked "XV";
5. $138^{\circ} 20'$ 376.0 feet along Government Main Road to + on set stone;
6. $175^{\circ} 33'$ 198.2 feet along Grant 4594, to E.P.Low, to a rock marked "XVI";
7. $234^{\circ} 44'$ 700.2 feet along Government Remnant to a + on set stone;
8. $298^{\circ} 11'$ 521.0 feet along Lot 14 to corner of wall;
9. $300^{\circ} 03'$ 500.0 feet along Lot 13 to the point of beginning.
