2. 155° 06' 2351.3 feet along Lot 17 to a + on set stone and ahu;
3. 258° 37' 1392.0 feet along 50 foot road to a + on set stone and ahu;
4. 328° 20' 2381.6 feet along the old government road to the point of beginning.
