Anahola Lots, Koolau, Kauai.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of a reserved lot on the West side of the Government Road, said point of beginning being $3^{\circ} 45' 100.0$ feet from a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the Southeast corner of the Anahola School Lot on the West side of the Government Road; from said pipe Trig. Station "Terrace" is by true azimuth and distance $237^{\circ} 06' 30'' 1646.1$ feet, Trig. Station "Kikoo" is $107^{\circ} 24' 30''$ and the Church Spire is $339^{\circ} 13' 30''$; as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $3^{\circ} 45'$ 108.9 feet along Government Road to a pipe;
2. $356^{\circ} 07'$ 143.0 feet along Government Road;
3. $93^{\circ} 45'$ 179.0 feet along Government land;
4. $155^{\circ} 48'$ 283.7 feet along Government land;
5. $273^{\circ} 45'$ 293.0 feet along the reserved lot to the point of beginning.
