Beginning at a + on pahoehoe and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 15, on the boundary between the lands of Kealahou and Keahuolu, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Keahuolu" being: 3486.2 feet North and 2912.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2122, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 76° 50' 1480.0 feet along the land of Keahuolu to a + on pahoehoe and ahu;
2. 155° 06' 2400.5 feet along Lot 19 to a + on pahoehoe and ahu;
3. 258° 37' 1492.0 feet along 50 foot road to a + on pahoehoe and ahu, the same being the Northwest corner of Lot 15;
4. 335° 06' 2351.3 feet along Lot 15 to the point of beginning.
