Anahola Lots, Koolau, Kauai.

Beginning at a + on a stone at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 18, the West corner of Lot 11, and the Northwest corner of L.C.A. 5022:2 to Kunane, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Terrace" is by true azimuth and distance $237^{\circ} 14'$ 1416.1 feet, Trig. Station "Kikoo" is by true azimuth $105^{\circ} 28'$ and the Church Spire is $344^{\circ} 43'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $14^{\circ} 41'$ 244.2 feet along L.C.A. 5022:2 to Kunane to + on stone;
2. ~~$74^{\circ} 44'$~~ 84.6 feet along Right-of-Way to + on stone;
3. $183^{\circ} 45'$ 238.5 feet along Government Road to + on stone;
4. $273^{\circ} 45'$ 131.0 feet along Lot 18 to the point of beginning.
