Beginning at a spike and pile of stones at the East corner of this lot and the West corner of Aalapuna and Kilohana Avenues, the coordinates of which referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" are 3690.9 feet North and 10430.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2383, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 17° 24' 30" 100.0 feet along Kilohana Avenue to spike and pile of stones;
2. 107° 24' 30" 50.0 feet along Lot 6 to spike and pile of stones;
3. 197° 24' 30" 100.0 feet along Lot 2 to spike and pile of stones;
4. 287° 24' 30" 50.0 feet along Aalapuna Avenue to the point of beginning.
