Beginning at an ohia stump in a pile of stones at the East corner of this lot, on the South side of old Government Road and on the boundary between the lands of Makapuu and West Hoohoomaale, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Trig. Station "Malaeloa" being 2582.7 feet South and 388.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2649, and running by true bearings:-

1. N. $52^{\circ} 14'$ W. 664.0 feet along the South side of old Government Road (30 feet wide);
2. N. $88^{\circ} 54'$ W. 93.0 feet along same;
3. S. $82^{\circ} 40'$ W. 317.0 feet along same;
4. S. $88^{\circ} 38'$ W. 265.5 feet along same;
5. N. $79^{\circ} 13'$ W. 49.0 feet along same;
6. S. $26^{\circ} 46'$ W. 184.0 feet along Grant 1830, No. 2, to Oponui and Pali;
7. N. $60^{\circ} 42'$ W. 361.7 feet along same;
8. N. $28^{\circ} 45'$ E. 84.0 feet along same;
9. N. $63^{\circ} 36'$ W. 238.0 feet along the South side of old Government Road (30 feet wide);
10. N. $40^{\circ} 34'$ W. 551.0 feet along same to an ohia post which is S. $3^{\circ} 00'$ W. 23.0 feet from a large rock marked with a + in middle of Government Road, and at an angle in the boundary between the Hana and Koolau districts;

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11. S. 3° 00' W. 836.0 feet along the land of Ulaino to a waterfall in Haumea Stream;
12. Thence up said Haumea Stream to its junction with Mokolehua Stream, thence up Mokolehua Stream to the North side of new Government Road, the direct bearing and distance being: S. 23° 43' W. 2172.0 feet more or less;
13. Thence along the North side of new Government Road (50 feet wide) to an ohia post in a pile of stones on the boundary between the lands of Makapuu and West Honomaele, the direct bearing and distance being: S. 68° 58' E. 2414.0 feet more or less;

14. N. 17° 13' E. 2835.0 feet along the land of Honomaele to the point of beginning.
