


Beginning at a mamane post at the South corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 1 and on the East side of 40 foot homestead road, from which the Waiakoa Catholic Church Spire is by true azimuth $154^{\circ} 42'$ and the coordinates referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu Kahala" are 12143.5 feet South and 23118.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2239, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $199^{\circ} 45'$ 241.5 feet along East side of homestead road to  on rock;
2. $153^{\circ} 48'$ 277.0 feet along East side of homestead road to edge of gulch;
3. $127^{\circ} 00'$ 968.0 feet along East side of homestead road to a Δ on rock at fence corner at South corner of Grant 1210 apana 2 to Maia, from which the Waiakoa Cathl Church Spire is by true azimuth $156^{\circ} 30''$;
4. $228^{\circ} 45'$ 474.0 feet along Grant 1210 apana 2 to Maia;
5. $313^{\circ} 55'$ 1800.0 feet along the land of Waiakoa to arrow  on large solid rock at angle of fence amidst a grove of eucalyptus trees;
6. $81^{\circ} 35'$ 848.0 feet along Lot 1 to the point of beginning.
