Beginning at a mamane post at the Northwest corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 3 on the East side of the Waiohuli road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being: 3451.7 feet South and 19053.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 248° 59' 41.1 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
2. 292° 23' 135.2 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
3. 217° 24' 505.4 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
4. 236° 14' 45.9 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
5. 280° 14' 111.2 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
6. 242° 54' 90.2 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
7. 302° 57' 1997.0 feet along 40 foot road to a mamane post on the boundary of the mauka pasture land;
8. 39° 46' 1000.0 feet along the mauka pasture land to a mamane post
9. 129° 46' 2256.0 feet along Lot 3 to the point of beginning.
