2. 218° 20' 56.8 feet along L.C.A. 6146C to Mahoe to a + on stone;
3. 144° 01' 56.5 feet along stone-wall along government land to a + on stone;
4. 52° 20' 69.3 feet along L.C.A. 6456 to Keliimahiai to a + on stone;
5. 3° 20' 33.0 feet along L.C.A. 6146C to Mahoe to the point of beginning.
