Anahola Lots, Koolau, Kauai.

This lot is a small island in the marsh on the North side of the Anahola Stream.

Beginning at a red-wood post at the Southwest corner of L.C.A. 4724:2 to Mana, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Terrace" is by true azimuth and distance $112^{\circ} 10'$ 871.3 feet, Trig. Station "Pine" is $194^{\circ} 58'$ 644.3 feet, and the Church Spire is $27^{\circ} 25'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $270^{\circ} 43'$ 132.0 feet along L.C.A. 4724:2 to Mana;
2. $22^{\circ} 34'$ 159.6 feet along swamp;
3. $52^{\circ} 47'$ 260.2 feet along North bank of Anahola Stream;
4. $170^{\circ} 40'$ 83.3 feet along swamp;
5. $185^{\circ} 57'$ 185.7 feet along swamp;
6. $194^{\circ} 33'$ 164.2 feet along swamp;
7. $228^{\circ} 58'$ 53.2 feet along swamp;
8. $275^{\circ} 43'$ 113.5 feet along swamp;
9. $309^{\circ} 16'$ 100.1 feet along swamp;
10. $90^{\circ} 43'$ 154.6 feet along L.C.A. 4724:2 to Mana;
11. $350^{\circ} 43'$ 82.5 feet along L.C.A. 4724:2 to Mana to the point of beginning.
