Beginning at a + on a stone at the Southeast corner of this lot and on the West side of Kamane Road and the North side of a 10 Foot Right-of-Way to the rice fields, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Pine" is by true azimuth and distance $174^{\circ} 00' 30''$ 1640.3 feet and the Church Spire is $46^{\circ} 01'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2464, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $93^{\circ} 37'$ 91.9 feet along Right-of-Way;
2. $194^{\circ} 42'$ 77.5 feet along Lot 5;
3. $177^{\circ} 15'$ 128.1 feet along Lot 5;
4. $277^{\circ} 42'$ 53.7 feet along Government kula land;
5. $13^{\circ} 37'$ 125.4 feet along L.W.A. 4731:1 to Makuakane;
6. $273^{\circ} 37'$ 92.4 feet along L.C.A. 4731:1 to Makuakane;
7. $27^{\circ} 09'$ 83.0 feet along Kamane Road to the point of beginning.
