Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot at the East end of Camp Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanialai" being 8255.3 feet North and 2865.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $100^{\circ} 10'$ 220.0 feet along North side of Camp Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. $120^{\circ} 00'$ 453.7 feet along same to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. $211^{\circ} 00'$ 1369.4 feet along Lot 3 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. $302^{\circ} 04'$ 163.5 feet along Government Reserve to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. $340^{\circ} 00'$ 637.7 feet along Government Reserve to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. $31^{\circ} 00'$ 879.0 feet along Lot 1 to the point of beginning.
