Beginning at a post at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 36, at an angle in the West line of a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 327.9 feet South and 834.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 90° 00' 355.7 feet along Lot 36 to a post on the boundary of the land of Pakini-iki;
2. 171° 57' 1727.3 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a + on set stone and ahu;
3. 163° 45' 94.3 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a post;
4. 270° 00' 926.6 feet along Lot 24 and a 20 foot road to a + on set stone at corner of roads;
5. 357° 23' 1140.0 feet along the 30 foot road to a + on set stone;
6. 14° 59' 190.7 feet along the 30 foot road to a + on set stone;
7. 32° 35' 567.0 feet along the 30 foot road to the point of beginning.
